Excellent papers will be recommended to be published on the SCI/SCIE international journals after extension of the papers and an additional review process.** Prospective authors with the abstract accepted are invited to submit their full paper via the system of submission by **July 15, 2013**. Technical papers on the aspects related to (but not limited to) those in the topics of interest are invited for oral presentation. **Length of the full paper is limited within 4 pages (max).
